CLARIN is a digital infrastructure offering data, tools and services to support research based on language resources.

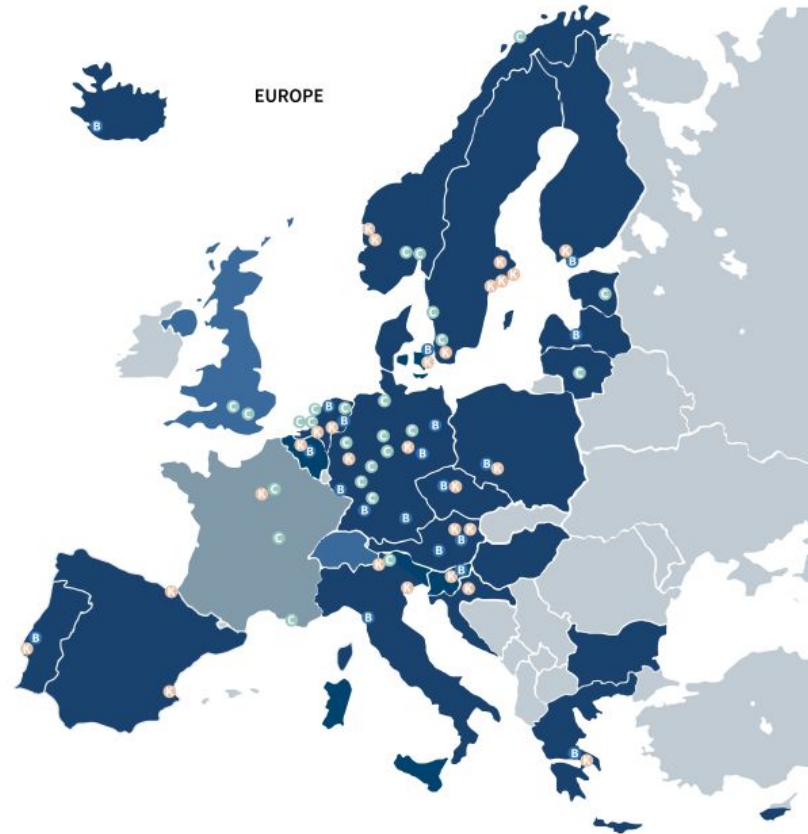
